Access internally was only gained in way of normally portable panels, no linings or fixed panelling were removed. The machinery was not stripped for examination, only checked where accessible externally. No fastenings or any hull fittings were drawn, no shafts drawn or rudders. No electrics or electronics were tested for function.

Tanks were only inspected where accessible externally, were not pressure tested and the contents not tested for contamination.

This report does not comment on compliance with National/International regulations such as RCD/MCA/BSS.
