2010 marks the 20th anniversary of "The Boathouse" chandlery at Preston Marina, and so to celebrate we are going to offer berthholders of Preston Marina a 10% discount off chandlery stock purchases for 12 months starting October 1st 2009. This is hopefully a welcome extension to our normal 3 month winter only discount offered to berth-holders, and comes at a time where every penny counts in the harsh economic climate we all face.

Thirdly, it only applies to our marked price on items already in stock in the chandlery (although some special orders may be discounted at our discretion). Unfortunately there do need to be some exceptions to the discount scheme - specifically diesel and calor gas, already discounted items and coffee shop purchases. ### **Lock Gate Operations** from October '09

A change this year from previous years to the operation of the lock gates means that as of October 1st (as opposed to November 1st) until April 1st 2010 the lock gates need to be booked on a Monday to Friday, a minimum 24 hours in advance of the tide.

The gates can still operate on any daylight tide -1/+2hrsLiverpool H.W. but the marina office must be given at least 24 hours notice during the working week, and please, as always, only book the locks if you actually intend to use them. If the locks are needed at weekends please ensure the request is made at least 24 hours in advance of the tide on the Friday.

To book the locks please contact the marina office between 10am - 3.30pm Mondays-Fridays on 01772 733595 (this timing co-ordinates with Preston City Council's Riversway office who operate the locks)
